Dear Parents,

Parent-Teacher Conferences will be held during the week of October 23 – 27, 2017. We will be on minimum day schedule for the entire week. All kindergarten students will attend school from 8:00 AM to 11:30 AM and students in grades 1 - 6 will attend school from 8:00 AM to 12:30 PM every day.

As the time approaches to meet with your child's teacher, take some time to prepare for the conference.

1. Talk to your child. Ask him/her to tell you what he/she thinks are their easiest and hardest subjects – and why. Ask him/her if he/she has any questions he/she would like to ask.
2. Write down your questions. Ask things such as:
 - Does my child participate in class discussions and activities?
 - Is my child in different groups for different subjects?
 - Is my child working up to their ability?
 - How well does my child get along with others?
3. Think of things the teacher needs to know. You know your child better than anyone else.
4. Time is of the essence. Teachers usually have many conferences scheduled during a single day. Arriving promptly will allow you to take full advantage of your time and allow the teacher to adhere to his/her schedule.
5. Create an action plan. Ask the teacher what you can do at home to reinforce what is happening at school.
